Species Lists

Areas 1 - 3 Bent and fescue grassland, with abundant Yorkshire fog and some native ryegrass and meadow foxtail. Soft rush, white clover, dandelion, creeping and meadow buttercups, creeping and spear thistles, stinging nettles, broadleaved dock and some birdsfoot trefoil in grass under fence that divides **Enclosure 1** from **Enclosure 2** where the sward is protected for grazing and trampling.

Areas 4 – 5 Marshy bent and Yorkshire fog grassland with tufted hairgrass, compact and soft rushes, greater birdsfoot trefoil and marsh thistles. Strongly reminiscent, but not totally representative, of Culm grassland

Hedge 1 Oak, hawthorn, blackthorn, willow, dogrose and occasional hazel

Hedge 2 Oak, brown birch, willow, hawthorn, blackthorn, hazel, dogrose

Hedge 3 Oak, willow, hawthorn, blackthorn, field rose, and occasional hazel

Hedge 4 Oak, willow, hawthorn, blackthorn and field rose

Hedge 4 Oak, hawthorn, blackthorn, willow, dogrose and occasional hazel

Trees (Not in hedges) None
